
Library News

Intro to Ancestry

On Saturday, Jul. 18 from 2:00 - 5:00 p.m., Adult Services Librarian Mary Bell will show you how to use the library's edition of Ancestry.com to search for records of your family history. Census records, military records, and more world records are available through this database that you can use any time you come into the library.



After a brief overview and demonstration in the Brooks Room, we will have time for hands-on exploration on library computers. A basic "starter kit" with a lineage chart and suggestions will be provided to all participants.

Summer Reading Club

Children will be asked to read for at least 21 days during the summer. Working toward this goal, they will receive incentives along the way. Each child who completes his or her 21 days of reading will be invited to a private rollerskating party in August. The child will also receive a finger puppet, free prizes, and a free paperback book. A variety of special events will be offered throughout the summer, such as T-Bone's Big Heroic Adventure, Sir George and the Dragon, Toe Jam Puppet Band, Awesome Rob, storytimes, Circus

Minimus, and a LEGOs session. Students going into grades 6 and up will join the Teen portion of the summer reading club and will have their own programs.
